Short description

Since the Rio Earth Summit (UN Conference on Environment and Development), 1992, the concept of **sustainable development** is well recognized and is supposed to be integrated as a cross-cutting issue at global and local levels. To reach those ambitious goals and, above all, to transform this concept into concrete, it is **essential to offer public and private actors, students, unemployed people and workers, specific training through innovative and practical tools, targeted to their needs.**

PASDEL : Practicing Sustainable Development through E-learning, under the European program Leonardo Da Vinci aims to achieve that goal at European level, especially in new member states.

This 2 year pilot project (from October 2006 to October 2008) associates **10 partners from 7 European countries** who will build **e-learning modules in their national language** to tackle priority environmental issues in their country and region, based on a common structure and on the pioneer experience of the « Academy of Sustainable and Human Development » in France (ADDH).

Objectives

- To involve local actors of different sectors in writing and testing of modules for the **best transferability at local level** ;
- To improve the capacity of **public and private organizations** to integrate sustainable development aspects in all levels of decision-making ;
- To facilitate the widest access to potential users : **university students, NGO's and business managers...**

How?

PASDEL is innovating e-learning by **sharing expertise to develop e-learning modules** on various themes in the field of **sustainable development**.

The e-learning modules will be developed in 5 countries : **Romania, Poland, Czech Republic, France and Belgium**, on the themes defined as their priorities :

- **Sustainable development in private companies** : available in all countries
- **Green architecture in buildings** : Czech Republic and Belgium
- **Transports** : Czech Republic and Poland
- **Waste** : Poland and Romania
- **Local Agenda 21** : Belgium and Romania

For who?

The e-learning training modules are developed for various target audiences defined in each country : employees of the governmental, non-governmental and business sectors, university students...

Results

- **In October 2008, an online training platform of e-learning modules on sustainable development themes** available in 5 European languages for the various target groups (individual and groups, private and public sectors) ;
- **a European network of actors of private and public sectors** which will use, implement and disseminate the work of PASDEL.
